
Greater Des Moines USBC Youth Tournament Rules

1. **TOURNAMENT:** Open to call members of a USBC Youth Division League, certified for the 2025-2026 season.
2. **EVENTS:** TEAM, SINGLES, DOUBLES and ALL EVENTS. Divisions will be according to average based on enrollment counts. In case of low enrollments, there will only be one division. Teams will be comprised of four members. Teams and doubles may be all boys, all girls, or mixed. There will be two divisions determined by average in team, singles, and doubles and all events as followed:

Division	Team	Doubles	Singles
1	601 & Over	301 & Over	151 & Over
2	600 & Under	300 & Over	150 & Under

3. **ENTRANTS:** Must bowl both Singles and Doubles to bowl either. Youth City Tournament will be held in one shift per day and Bowlers will choose to compete Singles and Doubles first, or Team. Only S/D or Team may be bowled per shift.

4. **AVERAGES:** Participants will use their highest sanctioned average, accepted in the following order:
 - a. Highest book (bowl.com) average from 2025-2026 (winter or summer), 12 game minimum.
 - b. Highest current average, 12 game minimum, as of April 1, 2026
 - c. If no average available, entrant SHALL be assigned the following averages:



4. **AVERAGES:** Participants will use their highest sanctioned average, accepted in the following order:
 - d. USBC rule 319a (10 pin rule) WILL APPLY. The current season average (min 12 games) as of April 1, 2026, is 10 or more pins higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used.

e. USBC rule 319e and 319d WILL APPLY

f. LEAGUE OFFICER IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AVERAGE SHEETS FROM ALL JUNIOR LEAGUES AS OF April 1, 2026.

5. **HANDICAP:** Shall be based on 90% of 220 for Singles, 440 for Doubles, and 880 for Team.

6. **SUBSTITUTES:** Shall be allowed prior to scheduled time to bowl with completed substitution form and will be allowed in the samelineup position. Once a substitute starts an event (scoring), that bowler MUST complete the event.

7. **LINE-UP:** Shall be set as listed on the tournament entry form.

8. **CHECK-IN:** Will be completed no later than one half hour prior to scheduled start time and shall be completed on an INDIVIDUAL BASIS. 2025-2026 USBC membership cards SHALL be presented in Check-In.

9. **TARDY BOWLERS:** Bowlers or Teams arriving late will receive a zero for every frame missed and can begin play with the current frame being bowled. No absentee or blind score will be permitted.

10. **ENTRY FEES:** \$30.00 per event. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE RETURNED ONCE ACCEPTED.

11. **PRIZES:** All prizes shall be awarded in the form of SMART scholarships in a ratio of at least 1:5. All award fees shall be returned 100%, in the form of non-monetary awards.

12. **DRESS CODE:** Blouses that are not tucked in must not show mid-section. Clothing that advertises alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products or depicts foul language or gestures will not be permitted. Tournament Director or designee's decisions as to the appropriateness of attire will be final.

13. **ONLY BOWLERS AND REGISTERED VOLUNTEERS (RVP Badges) ARE ALLOWED WITHIN THE BOWLERS AREA.**

14. **CLOSING DATE:** Entries must be postmarked by midnight, April 1, 2026.

15. **Any check in payment of entry fee for the tournament, returned for non-payment, will be assessed a service charge of \$50.00. Payment must be cleared prior to bowling.**

16. Any rule not covered by these Tournament Rules or Greater Des Moines USBC by-Laws will be covered by USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations.
17. Protests must be made within 72 hours of competition (Rule 329).
18. The decisions of the Greater Des Moines USBC Board is final.
