Frank began his career in 1913 at the age of 14. He was the organizer of the present Cedar Rapids Bowling Association. Frank did the whole job of running the Cedar Rapids BA for the next four years. As the organization began to grow he was elected secretary of the association, a position he held for the next 27 years. He continued to help organize various leagues and held various offices within the leagues along with being secretary of the Cedar Rapids BA.

During this time Frank has been an outstanding bowler, participating in a number of ABC tournaments, 18 state tournaments and at least 20 city tournaments. At present Frank bowls in two leagues and maintains a very respectable average of 183.

Frank holds a number of 700 series in his bowling career with a high of 739 and is a Life member of the 700 Bowling Clubs of America.

Frank remained very active in the Cedar Rapids BA and attends the Iowa State Council of Delegates meetings as a delegate of the Cedar Rapids BA and is 1st Vice-President of the CRBA.

Inducted into the Iowa Bowling Hall of Fame in March of 1961.
