

Chapin D. "Chick" Fellingham

Bowling ability was his catagory and was a good one, awarded Posthumously.

Chick helped organize the Boone Bowling Association and served as President of the association. Organize a number of leagues in Boone and during his bowling career was a league officer and served as secretary of two 10 team leagues at the time of his death.

He started bowling in the Iowa State Tournaments in 1923 and bowled in every one since that time but missed the 1957 tournament in Dubuque. Last state tournament was 1960 before his death in 1961.

Iowa State All Events Champion in 1926 with 1824 and again in 1932 with 1890.

He was known far and wide around the State of Iowa as a real competitor, boosting bowling whenever he got the chance. He never missed a City or County bowling tournament in 35 years.

Inducted into the Iowa Bowling Hall of Fame in March 1965, Posthumously.
