Bill was very active in bowling and its promotion in the Sioux City area. His first year of bowling he was elected secretary of his league. He continued active as secretary of 3 leagues in Northwest Iowa until 1949 when he was elected Secretary of the Sioux City Bowling Association, resigning that office in 1957.

Bill was elected a Director of the Iowa State Bowling Association in 1950 and was the ISBA President the 1958-59 season.

Bill managed the Sioux Village and Plaza Bowl Bowling Centers.

Bill was a outstanding bowler and maintained averages in the 190's. Bowled in a number of Iowa State Bowling Tournaments and was a member of the 1953 Iowa State Tournament Open Team Champions the Park Bowl team with a score of 2915.

Bill died while on vacation in Phoenix, Arizona in February of 1967.

Inducted into the Iowa Bowling Hall of Fame Posthumously in 1973.
