Orlin started his bowling career in the small town of May City, Iowa in 1947. They had only 4 lanes at the May City bowling establishment. Later on Orlin bowled in Milford, Iowa and when those bowling lanes were closed he started bowling in Spencer, Iowa.

In Spencer, Iowa Orlin took a very active part in the bowling activities of the Spencer Bowling Association. He has been a officer of the Spencer Area Bowling Association since 1959 and serve that association as its President for 5 years. He was voted a lifetime member of the Spencer Area Bowling Association in 1968.

The Spencer Women's Bowling Association needed help when they were in the process of getting started and Orlin helped them out with some needed advice, especially in constitution and by-laws. The women's association was so appreciative of the assistance given to them by Orlin that he was made a Honorary Member of the Spencer Women's Bowling Association in 1978.

Orlin has bowled in 27 Iowa State Tournaments and 26 ABC Tournaments.

Orlin organized the Spencer 700 Club Chapter 100 in 1974 and was the Pin Buoy of that 700 Club and is a member of the 700 Bowling Clubs of America.

Orlin help organize the Terril, Lake Park and Spirit Lake Bowling Associations and was President of the Spirit Lake BA.

Orlin's high game is 279 and high series is 705 bowled in 1962. Highest average was 196.

Orlin was elected a Director of the Iowa State Bowling Association in 1971 and served that association as President during the 1977-78 season. Orlin has been a very active Past President of the ISBA.

Elected to the Iowa Bowling Hall of Fame in March 1984.
