He got involved with the sport a little further when in 1980 he purchased Valley Park Lanes in Cedar Falls and then keeping his interest in Valley Park he became proprietor of the Rose Bowl Lanes in Mason City.

Dale's committment to our sport has served to promote, improve and encourage bowling in the city of Cedar Falls, the State of Iowa and on the National level.

Dale has since purchased a business and has relocated to Springfield, Illinois.
