He has attend most of the state conventions since 1945 and National conventions since 1950. Orville was very involved when Sioux City hosted the state bowling tournament, selling ads for the schedule book and working every day of the tournament. He has been bowling for 54 years.

He has always been available for his leadership and assistance whenever called upon. His position as advisor to the active board is unparalleled.
