Walter was elected to the Sioux City Bowling Hall of Fame in 1983, Posthumously.

He was the owner of the Park Bowl lanes and started bowling in 1930. He was very active with all organizations in the game of bowling. He helped the Junior program to be organized and to function. He was involved with the forming of the Sioux City bowling proprietors group and was associated with the state proprietors association and served as a vice president.

He had a high game of 300 many 700 series. Walter bowled in 34 city tournaments and won over 10 titles. Bowled in over 30 other tournaments with over 10 titles. He averaged over 190 in 20 ABC tournaments. He won an all events title in 1951 with an 1861 total.

He was a finalist in the National Master tournament and won the Sioux City Master tournament twice. He also was the Big Bowl winner on Television.

Walter was a person who always had time to help out a new bowler or to give advice to a veteran.

He played Pro baseball and was a member of the Sioux City Baseball Hall of Fame.

Inducted into the Iowa Bowling Hall of Fame in March 1990.
