He got involved with Cadillac Lanes in 1982 and is still partner and manager at this time.

Adrian was elected to the Waterloo Bowling Association Hall of Fame in 1983. Attended two National A.B.C. Conventions. Since being a Proprietor in 1978 he has belonged to the Iowa and National BPAA and has served on many committees and was elected to President in 1992.
