Cindy is an accountant at Bodine Electric she has been there for 11 years.

All have continued the family tradition of bowling. Terry is a very good bowler too, he has had at least 9 – 300 games and an 801 series and has averaged in the 200's for many years. At this time, Cindy does have bragging rights for High Series in their house with her 803. Cindy and Terry also coached baseball for the Dubuque Dodgers and kept league records for the A division of the Dubuque Independent League and Terry (Cindy – the accountant....) was the treasurer of the Dubuque Independent League.

Besides bowling, Cindy and Terry have spent many hours watching their children participate in all of their school and social activities from Band and Color Guard to Baseball, Softball, Karate, and Track. Terry and Ben are White Sox fans while Cindy is a die-hard Cub fan and they are also huge Indianapolis Colts fans too. Cindy's biggest passion besides her family is collecting the Disney Character "Goofy". A visitor to their house would see competition between Terry's Colts collection and Cindy's Goofy collection.

Cindy comes from a bowling family. Her mother and father, Jim and Jan Vogt managed Riverside Bowl for 24 years. Jim is a member of the local DBA Hall of Fame inducted in 1984. Jan is a member of the DWBA Hall of Fame and was inducted in 1987. Jan was also the 600 Club Secretary for 20 years – retiring in 1992. Cindy has 2 sisters and 2 brothers. Her sister Stephanie Beck is a member of the DWBA Hall of Fame (1990) and the IWBA Hall of Fame (1993), she has several 300's and 2 800 series. Her brother Dan lives in Denver Co. and has many 300 games and 700 series to his credit. Molly her youngest sister has pushed her once a week average to 195+, she also has several 700 series and has come close a couple of times to the 800 mark. Her brother Greg has started back in bowling after a 25+ year hiatus. He is currently carrying a 195+ average.

Her children also bowl. Jolene and Amy currently bowl with Cindy in league. Beth has bowled several 600 series this last season in league and averaged 188, Jolene averaged 168, and Amy averaged 155. Ben bowls in junior league on Saturday mornings and averages about 185 and has had several 600 series and has a high series of 712 and high game of 279. Terry bowls in 2 leagues and averages over 215, while Cindy bowls in 2 leagues – one of which is a family affair, with her mother, daughter and sister.

Bowling at IWBA State Tournament is always a family affair. This year we had Mom, all 3 sisters, and 4 daughters bowl on 3 different teams along with some good friends. State trips also include taking dad and the husbands along (the younger kids get left behind!). Dad especially enjoys watching the kids bowl in Thursday league together and always enjoys State – as someone is usually in the hunt for 1st place in one of the events.

Comments

Cindy is a very deserving candidate for the Hall of Fame.

Statistically she has several titles to her name: 1 (possibly 2) State title(s) in Division 1 Doubles, 5! – 2nd place finishes, and 3 – 3rd place finishes. She also had the High game one year at State. This year (2008) she is in the top 10 in all 4 events! She is a true team player – always putting her best efforts into the Team and Doubles events.

She has many City Records (3) and City titles (17) and at one time she (and her teammates) held 3 of the City Tournament Records. Through a 4 season stretch (1995-1998) she won at least one DWBA City Tournament Title, gathering a total of 7 Titles in that time frame.. She was the All Events with Handicap Record holder with a 2112 total – holding that title until they changed the handicapping method. Her 300 game ties her for high game with approximately 9 other bowlers, while her 803 is the second highest series ever bowled by a woman in Dubuque. Her average has consistently been in the top 5 in the city for the past 10 years and for the past 4 years has been 2nd to her Sister (she WILL get me one of these years!) She tied for the high Average in the 2001-02 season.

She represents everything that you would want in a member of the Hall of Fame. Besides all of the numbers – she has other Hall of Fame qualities that cannot be glorified by statistics. She is a loyal team member, participating in leagues and tournaments not just to win but to bowl with her friends and family many of which are lower average bowlers. She is a great sport, whether you are competing against her or with her. She is a fierce competitor and yet a friend at the same time. I have thoroughly enjoyed bowling with her, against her and next to her. I have seen her compete against professional bowlers and hold her own. She always has nice things to say to and about all her fellow bowlers, both low and high average alike. There are so many adjectives that you can use to describe her: Loyal, Good Sport, faithful, competitive, nice, smart, team player, sister, daughter, (grandmother!!), and lastly a great Friend.

I am proud to have been there when she shot her first 600, her first 700 and her 800 series. And I would be ecstatic to see her inducted into the Iowa Women's Bowling Hall of Fame. Nothing would make my family prouder then to see her inducted, and for her to shine in her own limelight and enjoy what she has accomplished.
