Picking up a bowling ball at a young age seemed like the right thing for Dan Schuler to do as a 9-year old. The attachment to the game continued as he competed in Cadillac Lane's Junior Program and subsequently for the Waterloo West team in high school.

After high school graduation as an 18-year old, Dan immediately joined the Waterloo Bowling Association. Over the last 44 years, he has had a great deal of success with honor scores and accomplishments.

Dan did not take long to record his first 700 series in October 1978 which occurred 6-weeks after joining Men's League and now has over five hundred 700 series to his credit.

As with many young bowlers who are developing their game, practice and patience eventually pays off. March 10th, 1986 Dan recorded his first honor score...a 298 game at Cadillac Lanes enroute to earning Waterloo's Bowler of the Year honor. This was the first of what would become many honor scores.
