- 3) Placed in the top 5 in any division of the AJBC/YABA/ABC/WIBC/USBC National Tournaments.
- 4) Won any division of a Local Association Tournament.
- 5) Placed in the top 3 in any division of any other Local, State or National Tournament.
- 6) Maintained a 190 average or better.
- 7) Has achieved an 800 series, 700 series, 300 game, 299 game, 298 game or rolled 11 in a row.

Dave started bowling at the age of 11 and won many youth tournaments during that time. He worked for Plamor Lanes in Iowa City from 1976 thru 1993. Winning 2nd place in the Petersen Classic (a National Tournament hosting over 34,000 bowlers from 38 states and 3 different countries in 2014) allowed him to invest in the purchase of Coral Lanes in Coralville, IA. During that time helped in getting the High School Bowling off the ground and hosted City High and West High – High School Teams. With only having 12 lanes it was a little cramped but they weathered through it. He also hosted many city and state tournaments at Coral Lanes.

In 2008 Dave not only lost his business to the flood he also lost his home which was above the bowling center. After the flood he did lane resurfacing and installation for 2 years. He is also a Certified Lane Inspector and a Certified Lane Dressing Inspector.

As you can see, Dave has had a life long passion for bowling and his dedication and his skill has brought him many rewards over the past 45 years. He hopes to continue with his love for bowling and be back in the proprietor position soon.
