Doug was born on September 18, 1958 in Dixon, Illinois and he now resides at 3024 Schick Court, Clinton, Iowa with his wife Terry. They are the parents of 5 children, Amanda, Sarah, Amber, Katherine and Devin.

He began his adult bowling in the Saturday Nite Live league at the Recreation Lanes, in Clinton, for the 1982-83 season. Since the 1985-86 bowling season he has bowled regularly in three sanctioned leagues.

Doug has bowled in 30 consecutive Clinton City tournaments, 27 Iowa State tournaments and 7 National tournaments. In addition he has bowled in numerous 700 Club and area Proprietor's tournaments and 10 Peterson Classics in Chicago.

Although Doug is an accomplished bowler having raised his average from a beginning 142 to 201 with numerous 700 series it is his dedication and service to the game of bowling that is worthy of merit. His quote: "I just enjoy the game of bowling and the people of the bowling world and I want to do what I can to make the game as much fun for others as it is for me." Again in 2010, he was honored as the Association's "Man of the Decade" for his tireless efforts that he put forth to improve the operation and image of the Clinton Bowling Association during the previous ten years.

He was instrumental in organizing fund raising activities for the Clinton Bowling Association Board at the annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Riverboat Days festival, the Miles Dirt Days and other events. Funds that were raised were added to the Clinton Bowling Association Scholarship Fund and were also used to supplement the CBA general fund.

Doug takes to the road and travels to represent the Clinton Bowling Association at all the Iowa State meetings. Since his election to the Clinton Bowling Association Board in 1991 he has attended every Iowa State Jamboree and with the exception of 2005 due to work obligations, has attended every annual State Meeting.

It is this type of dedication, enthusiasm, hard work and continuous effort in the promotion and furthering the game of bowling , on the local and state level that deserves your serious
