Budzyn, Jr. as a candidate for election to the Iowa State USBC Bowling Association Hall of Fame for his performance, dedication and service for the sport of bowling.

Ed was born on March 5, 1958 in Burlington, Iowa where he has lived there his whole life. He is married to his wife April for the past 35 years. They are the parents of Michelle, Amanda and Charles, and the grandparents of Mikayla, Katelyn and Mason.

Ed started bowling in the Junior Bowling Program at Bowl Inn Lanes at the age of eight years old. He discovered that he liked to bowl. He attributes his skills in the sport today, from the help of his coaches in the junior bowling programs along with his continued practice of the game.

He won The Hardees Junior Pro - Am in Davenport, IA while in junior leagues

When he was in high school his high school team qualified for the High School State Tournament in 1974, 1975 and 1976. In 1974 their team finished 2nd place and 13th place in 1975.

While attending Jr. College at Southeastern Community College, in 1977 his Jr. College Bowling team won the State Jr. College Tournament.

Ed moved up to the adult leagues in 1976 and bowled in the Sportsman's and Commercial Leagues at Bowl Inn Lanes. He has bowled in as many as 4 leagues in one year. He also was in a group that Traveled for 4 years to Muscatine on Tuesday nights and bowled in the Muscatine Classic League. Ed is currently bowling in the Burlington Champs League at King Pins. Our Association was again honored at the 1995 ABC Convention for winning the Five-Year Service Award. Ed was the chairman of the committee and again spent countless hours putting together our awards package and sending to ABC for consideration.

Ed was President of our Association in 1996 and 2007, and Chairman of State Tournament Committee in 2014 when Burlington hosted the Iowa State USBC Open Championship Tournament. He spent a lot of time and effort to make sure Burlington ran successful tournaments.

Ed is the Chairman of our Local Hall of Fame Board of Directors, which is made up entirely of the Hall of Fame Members. He was elected by that group to head the committee.

Ed put together our Local Association Policy Manual; he makes sure all the new board members get a note book with all information, including the policy manual to help them with their responsibilities as a Director.

Ed has also put together a book full of the History of the Burlington Area Bowling Association. He wanted to make sure the information of our Association would not be lost, and that it would be passed down to the younger generation of Board Members in the future.

Ed was the Transition Chairman heading the committee when our Association merged with the Women and Youth in 2017.

Ed has been the backbone of our Local Association for over 30 years, his leadership and mentoring of the new board members has been what has kept our Association moving forward through all the changes happening in the bowling world.
