He was elected to the Waterloo Hall of Fame in 2001.

In 1999, Darrell was elected to the State Board of Directors and worked through all of the director and vice president chairs and served as President during 2006-2007. During his time on the State Board, he established and maintained the State's web site and continues to serve as the State's web site coordinator. This web site is the information resource link between the State organization and all of its members. Darrell updates this website on a weekly basis to reflect the current standings during the lengthy State Tournament. He also has engineered this website to be the hub for all of the Local Association's websites making this site truly <u>the</u> place for all of the USBC BA bowling information in the state of Iowa.

In conclusion, Darrell Fremont has spent almost 30 years participating in league bowling and during most of that time has also served his fellow bowlers in various leadership positions. He has a warm and outgoing personality and continues to reach out to all bowlers with a helping hand. Although his life is busy from everyday work, family and State Board Association assignments, he has never turned down our call for help or advice. From being a League President all the way up to President of the State Organization, he has continuously given service to his fellow bowlers.
