He served on the board of the Greater Cedar Valley USBC BA from 1999 thru 2013 before being forced to resign due to health issues. During that time, Gene represented the senior bowlers of his association with a strong voice on the local board. He worked tirelessly to support the board whenever a state open or women's tournament was held in Waterloo. In 1999, Gene was presented with the local association Director of the Year Award and was presented the Board Dedication Award in 2013.

Gene volunteered to join the local Hall of Fame Committee in 1999 and still serves on that committee currently.

In 2001, Gene was elected to the lowa State Senior Bowling Board of Directors. He actively served on that board until health concerns forced his to retire while serving at the Vice President level.
