Nominee must be a present or former member of the lowa State USBC for at least 15 years (not necessarily consecutively) and participated in at least 5 lowa State USBC tournaments. To be considered for the award the nominee must have at least 5 of the following qualifications as an lowa State USBC member:

- 1) Placed in the top 3 of any division of the Iowa State USBC Championship Tournaments.
- 2) Won any division of an affiliate Iowa State USBC Bowling Tournament (Iowa State Senior Women's, Iowa 500 Club, Iowa 600 Club, Iowa 700 Club, or Iowa State Mixed Bowling Tournament).
- 3) Placed in the top 5 in any division of the AJBC/YABA/ABC/WIBC/USBC National Tournaments.
- 4) Won any division of a Local Association Tournament.
- 5) Placed in the top 3 in any division of any other Local, State or National Tournament.
- 6) Maintained a 190 average or better.
- 7) Has achieved an 800 series, 700 series, 300 game, 299 game, 298 game or rolled 11 in a row.
