- 2) Won any division of an affiliate Iowa State USBC Bowling Tournament (Iowa State Senior Women's, Iowa 500 Club, Iowa 600 Club, Iowa 700 Club, or Iowa State Mixed Bowling Tournament).
- 3) Placed in the top 5 in any division of the AJBC/YABA/ABC/WIBC/USBC National Tournaments.
- 4) Won any division of a Local Association Tournament.
- 5) Placed in the top 3 in any division of any other Local, State or National Tournament.
- 6) Maintained a 190 average or better.
- 7) Has achieved an 800 series, 700 series, 300 game, 299 game, 298 game or rolled 11 in a row.

she averaged 198 in one league and 192 in another, In 2011-12 she averaged 194, In 2012- 13 she averaged 199, In 2013 – 14 she averaged 192, In 2014 – 15 she averaged 196, And in 2017 – 18 she averaged 190

Kathy has had shot three 700 series during her career. In 1988- 89 season she shot a 744 series in the 2000 – 01 season she had a 705 series, and in 2019 state tournament she had a 701 series.

Kathy has bowled 29 Games over 250, 5 Games over 275.

Kathy has bowled 48 series above 650 and 3 – 700 series during her career.

Kathy has been on the Burlington Women's All-Star Scratch Teams many times. She was a 1st Team member for 26 years averaging between 175 to 199. Starting in 1998 - 89 season, 1989 – 90 season, 1990- 91 season, had a break for several years then starting in the 1997 – 98 season for ever season after that she has been a 1st Team Member, she was a 2nd Team member once during the 1994 – 95 season.

Kathy has been the Burlington Women's Association Bowler of the Year for ten different seasons 1988, 1989, 2000, 2001,2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2009, 2018.

Kathy has bowled in all the Local Association Tournaments. In the Women's Annual Championship Tournament's, she has done very well.

In 1987 - 88 season she Placed 1st in All- Events Scratch and HDCP, 2nd in singles, and 3rd in Team

1995 Her team took 1st place

2006 her team took 1st place she was 3rd in singles, 1st in All-Events Scratch and HDCP,

2007 2nd place Team, 2nd place Doubles, 1st All – Event HDCP and 2nd All-Event Scratch

2008 1st Place All – Event Scratch and HDCP

2010 1st Place Singles, 1st place All – Events Scratch

2012 1st place Team, 1st Place All – Event Scratch

2018 1st place Team, 1st Place Singles, 3rd Place All - Events

She bowled in the Match Games and took 2nd place in 1992

Kathy has bowled in many local and regional tournaments. She has bowled in both the Women's and Men's Tournament in Springfield ILL.

Kathy Bowls in the Women's State Tournament for many years and she also has bowled at Women's National Tournament for many years

Kathy bowled in the Queens Tournament in 2003 in the Qualifying round she placed 172nd out of the 339 bowlers that bowled in that event

Kathy received the Burlington Women's Association Secretary Award in 2009

Kathy Received the Burlington Women's Association Merit Award in 2007

Kathy was elected into the Burlington Women's Hall of Fame in 2001 and has served on the Women's Hall of Fame Election Committee ever since.
