SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

Nominee must be a present or former member of the Iowa State USBC for at least 15 years (not necessarily consecutively) and participated in at least 5 Iowa State USBC tournaments. To be considered for the award the nominee must have at least 5 of the following qualifications as an Iowa State USBC member:

- 1) Placed in the top 3 of any division of the Iowa State USBC Championship Tournaments.
- 2) Won any division of an affiliate Iowa State USBC Bowling Tournament (Iowa State Senior Women's, Iowa 500 Club, Iowa 600 Club, Iowa 700 Club, or Iowa State Mixed Bowling Tournament).
- 3) Placed in the top 5 in any division of the AJBC/YABA/ABC/WIBC/USBC National Tournaments.
- 4) Won any division of a Local Association Tournament.
- 5) Placed in the top 3 in any division of any other Local, State or National Tournament.
- 6) Maintained a 190 average or better.
- 7) Has achieved an 800 series, 700 series, 300 game, 299 game, 298 game or rolled 11 in a row.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE

Nominee must be a present or former member of the Iowa State USBC for at least 15 years (not necessarily consecutively). To be considered for the award the nominee must have at least 5 of the following qualifications as an Iowa State USBC member:

- 1) Served as an officer or director of the state board.
- 2) Served as a chairman of a committee of the state association.
- 3) Served on a committee of the state association.
- 4) Served as a state delegate (a minimum of 5 years).
- 5) Served as an ABC/WIBC/USBC delegate.
- 6) Served in some capacity in any Iowa State USBC Open/WBA state tournaments.
- 7) Outstanding support of Iowa State USBC activities, or been a recipient of any Iowa State USBC award (examples: BVL, Bowl for the Cure, Outstanding Association Manager, Workshop(s), Above & Beyond, Friendship or Spirit Award, etc.).
- 8) Served as a National officer, director or committee member.
- 9) Served as a manager/secretary of BVL, Bowl for the Cure, AJBC/YABA, Iowa Bowling Council, Iowa 500 Club, Iowa 600 Club, Iowa 700 Club, Iowa 20-Year Club or Iowa Women Bowling Writer's Club and/or an officer, director or manager of other related Iowa State bowling organizations.
