Shellie Kutsch (Performance/Meritorious Service) of Dubuque, IA, will be inducted into the Iowa State USBC BA Hall Of Fame on June 25, 2022 along with 3 others; Arthur Bacon (Meritorious Service) of Ft Dodge, IA, Rich Eighme (Performance) of Waterloo, IA, and Sharon Parrish (Meritorious/Ambassador) of Burlington, IA

Shellie has served in numerous capacities for the sport of bowling here in Iowa, Director for Iowa State WBA 2013-2018, Director for Iowa State USBC BA 2018-present, Iowa State Tournament Director 2018-present, Awards committee 2019-2021, Hall of Fame 2019-2021 and had been a delegate to the State 2000-2013.

Kutsch has held other positions at the state and local levels as well that include; Secretary for the Iowa Women's 700 Club 2014-present, President 6 years for the Dubuque Women's 600 Club, on the Dubuque Youth Board for 6 years, Dubuque WBA Board for 20 years (President for 8 years) and currently serving the Dubuque Area Board as 1st Vice President 2018-present.
