In 2018 the Iowa State Women's Bowling Association established a \$1,000 scholarship to award deserving youth female and male bowlers for their accomplishments on the lanes, in their communities, and in the classroom. The scholarship was revised to award four individuals \$1000 each for one year from one individual awarded \$1000 for four years at a meeting on April 16, 2021.

<p><u>Applicants must meet the following general qualifications:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a graduating senior from any high school. 2. Must have bowled USBC Youth League the 4 years of high school. 3. Enrolled or plan to enroll and pursue a degree at a 2 or 4-year accredited college, university, or enroll in a vocational-technical school. 4. Be bowling in an Iowa State USBC certified league. 5. Have a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 GPA scale high school grade point average at time of application. 	<p><u>Applicants must submit the following by March 1:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This application completely filled out and signed by applicant. 2. Transcript OR most recent grade report. 3. Achievements and activities. 4. Counselor's letter of recommendation. 5. One-page essay from the applicant on "What life lessons has bowling taught me and where do I see myself in 5 years" (type or computer-generate your essay of at least 150-200 words).
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This application and all required documents to be submitted must be postmarked no later than March 1 annually.
