



**Linda Roberson – Inducted into the
the Muscatine USBC, Inc Women’s Hall of Fame – April 18, 2008**

We would like to submit the name of Linda Roberson for recognition in the Muscatine USBC, Inc. Women’s Hall of Fame.

She has been participating in leagues since 1988 (at least that is what we have been able to reconstruct from old average books). Prior to that, she was sitting on the side lines encouraging her sons and supporting her husband in their bowling and tournament participation.

She has been listed as one of the higher average bowlers since 1993. In 1997-98 season posted a 202 average and was averaging over 200 in ABC leagues under the open division, but was not recognized by WIBC for their award of having average over 200 (203) until the 2002-2003 season with an average posting in a Women’s league.

She has participated in four (4) Sweet Sixteen tournaments and has earned a spot in this year’s Tournament and also has qualified as First for the first Women’s Senior Tournament with scores posted from this season’s City Tournament. In 1998 she finished 2nd in the Sweet Sixteen tournament. Her team finished first in this year’s City Tournament. She was on the first place Team for the 2007 City Tournament, too. She has been a member of many First place teams during her league competition over her years of participation. She has competed in six (6) national WIBC tournaments and ten (10) Iowa WBA Tournaments. She is a member of a four-person mixed team that has been recognized for having finished 2nd on the National level for 95-96 season 2863 scratch 3 game series. She finished first in the 600 Doubles tournament in 1996. She also finished first in the 600 Team Tournament in 2006.

She bowled a 298 during the 1998-1999 bowling season, but her high game of 300 was bowled in the Muscatine Classic League on March 18, 2003. She was subbing and her husband, Larry, was away

competing in the National tournament. Even though this was not recognized by WIBC, it was bowled and sanctioned. Then on 9-20-2003 she bowled her highest series of 792 in the Guys and Dolls Mixed League with games of 286-278-228. She has bowled 8 games over 280 and has bowled over 40 700 series and more than 8 series that were over 750. She continues to support the women's and men's leagues in which she has bowled by finding bowlers to complete teams. She competes in both Women's and Men's local tournaments. We are sure that she is looking forward sitting on the side lines encouraging her grandchildren in their future bowling participation and staying active with more competition.

It is with great respect that we submit the name of Linda Roberson for recognition in the Muscatine USBC, Inc. Women's Hall of Fame.
