

Tabitha Bieri Inducted Into Muscatine USBC, Inc Women's Hall of Fame May 1, 2009 Outstanding Achievement

We would like to submit the name of Tabitha Bieri for recognition in the Muscatine USBC, Inc. Women's Hall of Fame.

She started participating in youth leagues since 1988 at age 5 with an average of 60. She now has two boys in the youth program bowling their first season in PeeWee's with games in the 90's and 120's. In the 2000-2001 final average posting under YABA, she was averaging 200. She bowled her first sanctioned 300 (9-10-2000) in competition at Maple Lanes in Waterloo in YABA tournament competition. She achieved several 700's while participating in YABA leagues and tournaments. She participated in YABA Junior Olympic Gold tournament in Reno, Nevada in April, 2001.

She joined women's leagues in the 2001-02 bowling season and finished with a 214 average. She bowled a 290 for 11 strikes in a row in October, 2002. She was honored for 269 (11-in-a row) and 747 series and a 203 average for the 2003-04 season. She rolled a 298 game en-route to a 735 series in February, 2006. She rolled a perfect 300 game at 30 Lanes in Davenport in March, 2006 competition for State Tournament and went on to win the Doubles State Championship title for Division I. She rolled a 299 game in January, 2007. Most recently she rolled a 298 in Cedar Rapids for Doubles competition and 299 in Singles competition and is currently leading All Events, Doubles and Singles along with Team – even though competition is just starting, she always sets the mark to force everyone to do their best. She holds a 220 average while bowling in the Ladies Scratch League. The 700's are so numerous to count, with a 764 for a high personal series bowled in October, 2008 for this season's high (so far).

She will be participating in her seventh (7) Sweet Sixteen tournament as this year's top qualifier. She was the winner of 2007 tournament. Her team finished first in 2008 City Tournament. She shared the Doubles title for this year's City. She has been a member of first place team in Ladies Scratch League and recognized for many high games and series accomplishments. She has competed in four (4) Iowa USBC WBA Tournaments. She was State WIBC Doubles Champ, bowling a 300 game in the process (3-19-06717 233-300-184).
