She has been bowling for over forty years. She has bowled in leagues in Iowa City, West Liberty & Muscatine. In 2002-2003 when Liberty Lanes closed, some of the women chose to bowl in the Ladies Major League on Monday night. She was one of those women and through the last 11 years has bowled in The Sunday Mooners, King & Queens, Adult & Youth Summer League, Ladies City, Friday Swingers and currently bowls in the Afternoon Loafers League and Friday Senior Strikers League where she serves as Secretary-Treasurer.

She was elected to the MWBA Board of Directors and served 4 years as a Director and helped through the transition and merge of the three associations to the Muscatine USBC Bowling Inc. She was elected to the new Board as a Director and served 4 years in that position, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President, 1 year as 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President and currently is Sergeant at Arms. She has served and chaired on most of the Board Committees. She has been elected and served the last 7 years as a state Delegate to the ISUSBCWBA Inc. Annual Meeting.

She has been active in the efforts to bring the Men, Women and Youth State Tournaments to Muscatine, (even becoming an Ear of Corn for our skit during the women's bid for the 2005 State Tournament). You can depend on her being at the lanes to help when needed during State, City, Sweet 16, Bowler of the Year, Youth Pepsi and Youth City Tournaments by keeping score, brackets, and office help.

As Secretary Treasurer of the Muscatine 600 Club. She collects State and Local dues, runs the local 600 Club Team and Doubles Tournaments. She attends the State 600 Club meeting at the Annual Meeting during convention.

She has bowled in 33 National Tournaments and has received a Plaque from Nationals for a 25 and 30-year attendance award and we are sure she will keep attending them to reach her 35<sup>th</sup> year award. She probably has as many or more years in attendance at the State Tournaments. She also supports our local City Tournament by entering every year and has qualified several times in the Senior Bowler of the year. She participates in the ISUSBCWBA Senior Tournament every year. Last year she organized two teams to travel to Lansing Michigan to bowl in the first women's Midwest Tournament, she will be attending this year again in South Bend, Indiana.

She has supported bowling through the years by encouraging her daughter to bowl with her and her grandchildren to bowl in the youth leagues.....Don't forget her bowling friends who she always manages to talk them into attending tournaments with her.
