Over a span of 37 plus years, this bowler has averaged between 203-229. He has numerous 700 series; 11 300 games; and 4 800 series. He has qualified for the Bowler of the Year six (6) times, finishing as high as 2nd place. He has also qualified for Senior Bowler of the Year every year since being eligible.

He has served as league secretary in several leagues for many years.

He was a member of the 1983 Iowa State 700 Club championship team. In 1992, he won the singles title for the Moose International Tournament.

His best season would have to be the 1995-1996 season! He is a member of the Mixed Team (2 women/2 men) that held the 2nd highest 3 game series in the NATION - a 2863 scratch total. Individually, this bowler rolled games of 278, 300 and 300 for an 878 series on October 21, 1995. This score gave him the honor of holding the Iowa State Bowling Association high series for several years. Also, for the '95-'96 season, he was awarded the Fred Lipoveta Memorial Award, for the highest 3 game series that season.

We would like to nominate Neil Kenneth "Kenny" Greenwald, Jr. for the Muscatine USBC Hall of Fame. We feel this honor is long overdue.
