

Jeff Osborn Inducted Into Muscatine USBC, Inc Men's Hall of Fame May 1, 2009 Meritorious Service-Posthumous

We would like to submit the name of Jeff Osborn for posthumous recognition in the Muscatine USBC, Inc. Hall of Fame.

We wish to list some of Jeff's bowling accomplishments. We can only document what was left on association computers which were started only in 2000. Much will be missing, but we fondly remember the many stories.

His highest average was the 229 for the 2003-2004 bowling season, the year of his passing. He bowled multiple 300's in the 2002-2003 bowling season; 298 in September, 2003. With the 300 that he bowled in February, 2003, he also posted a series of 823. He rolled a 290 for 11-in-a row in October 2003; and again, another 290 for 11-in-a row just before he died in January, 2004. He even mastered the "Big 4" split conversion in January, 2003. This just shows how he was stopped in his prime.

He participated in many, many City, State and National Tournaments – always sharing the fun side along with his skills.

He started to serve on the Muscatine Men's Bowling Association in the 1996-97 bowling season when he started as a Director. He took on the offices in the order of progression through those offices. He was serving as Vice-President at the time of his sudden passing on January 12, 2004. His assistance in Board matters and tournaments always was presented with a positive approach.

We regret that this wasn't done when we could help him celebrate; however, it is with great respect that we submit the name of Jeff Osborn for recognition in the Muscatine USBC, Inc. Hall of Fame.
